Waukesha mayor, Robert Redford talk environment Nelson attended summit sponsored by actor/activist

WAUKESHA - What do Waukesha Mayor Larry Nelson and actor Robert Redford have in common?

They both are committed to the environment and they recently got the chance to chat face-to-face about just that.

Nelson returned Wednesday from the Sundance Summit, a three-day conference on climate protection with mayors from around the country in Sundance, Utah, hosted by Redford and Salt Lake City Mayor Rocky Anderson.

"Robert Redford is very committed on this issue," Nelson said Thursday as he sorted through a large stack of information he brought back from the conference. "His leadership dates back to the 1980s when he hosted an international summit at Sundance to address global warming."
